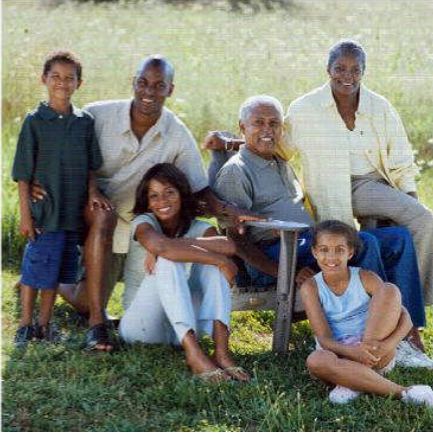




CICC's Effective Black Parenting
